
Step 1 – Wall Mounting



- Identify a suitable position on the wall to mount the termination box (1), check the position to ensuring no concealed services are present.
- Using a 6mm drill bit carefully drill two holes on positions marked approximately 30mm.




Step 2



- Using flush cutting tool, cut the cable entry port as shown above to allow the cable / tube into the termination box.
- Using the 2 screws provided screw the termination box to the wall. NB remove the 4th pigtail from the uniter to gain access to the mounting hole.



Step 3




- Using the cable tie provided fix the cable / tube as shown above.
- Route the input fibres through the track feeding them into the fibre entry point on the splice tray as indicated above.








• The fibres will appear on the splice tray to the right-hand side of the splice tray. Pull the fibre on to the splice tray ensuring it is not caught or trapped at any point. Store the fibres in a clockwise direction on the tray within the storage area, NB the ends of the fibre can be stored around the inside of the mandrel for easy access in the future.








- Carefully uncoil all fibres from the storage area.
- Separate the primary coated fibres from the cable, from the pigtails and safely store fibres for splicing.
- Splice the fibres.





- Place the splice protector in the appropriate storage bay.
- Route both the primary coated fibres around the outer track from the splice bay to form two loops.




Step 7



- Put the loops of fibre away as shown. Ensure that the fibres are stored below the tray retention tabs.
- Repeat steps 5 to 7 for all required splices.
- Fibre installation is now complete.





- To replace the cover, firstly hook the cover onto the base locating the two 'hooks' at the top of the unit.
- Gently press the cover over the tray until the cover is closed. Press firmly on the bottom right hand corner to ensure the locking pin has been located.
- Tighten the screw in the bottom left hand corner.



NOTE:		
To remove the cover first remove the screw in the bottom left hand corner. Hinge the cover from the bottom right hand corner until the cover has been removed.
