

Flexibox - Security lock Installation

Description

The Flexibox security lock can be retrofitted to any Flexibox to provide security against unauthorised access.

Tools Required

Tools:

Small hammer, screwdriver, adjustable spanner (optional).

1.0 Box Opening

Step 1



- If installing an external Flexibox (this will be black in colour) then using a flathead screwdriver, pivot the 4 toggles into the open position.
- For an internal Flexibox, skip to step 2.


With the toggles in the unlock position:

• Simultaneously push the two clips on the bottom face and lift to open the cover using the small tabs on either side.







• With the cover open at around 90°, push the tab on the top face as indicated and slide the cover right horizontally to remove.

You are now ready to add the security lock.

Step 1



- Take the security lock kit out of the packaging and separate all components.
- Check all components are in the package as above.



- Hold the barrel and turn the key anti-clockwise as far as it will go.
- Place on a surface with the cam out to the left. The key should be in this position.



Step 3
• Tap a hammer onto the end of a screwdriver or like remove the plastic from the cover.
NOTE: the plastic is very thin, so it does not need excessive force to remove. It is recommended that you remove the cover from the base first.

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Step 4



- Ensure the seal is placed on the underside of the lock head.
- Place the cam through the knocked-out hole in the box so the cam is in the position as shown.

NOTE: the cam should only rotate 90° to the stop on the inside.



Step 5



• Feed the metallic nut over the cam and secure in position using a spanner if required.

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



• Ensure the cam still only rotates 90° and the key can only be removed when the cam is back to its vertical (lock) position.

The installation of the lock is complete.



Step 6





- To close box, first ensure any excess fibre elements are stored appropriately inside the storage catches particularly that the elements do not sit above the tab as indicated.
- Allow a minimum of 30mm distance between stored elements and end of tab.



Step 2





If Cover was removed

- To add cover, slide horizontally along hinge axis until an audible click is heard.
- Ensure the cover hinge has passed the base tab, as indicated.



Step 3
If Cover was not removed
• Snap the cover over the bump on the base and gently bring down to the close position.
Do not allow the cover to slam shut.

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


Step 4



• Ensure the two clips are fully engaged at the front.





• Turn the key 90° anti-clockwise to secure and remove key.

NOTE: you cannot remove the key when the box is unlocked.



Step 6



• If using an external box, ensure all 4 toggles are snapped into the close position. An audible click should be heard.

Note: failure to do this may result in moisture ingress.
