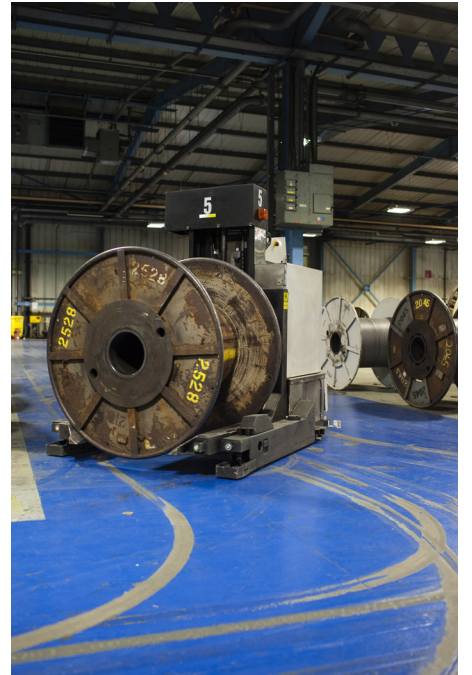

In this role, you will:

CAD Design Test Engineer – Components

Prysmian Group are pleased to offer a 12-month placement position as a CAD Design Test Engineer within the Components Business.

The Components Business sits in the Energy sector and designs, manufactures, and supplies state-of-the-art low and medium-voltage cable accessories that enable customers' installation requirements. Products we supply hold, join, terminate, and protect our customer's vital cable assets.

This role will allow the successful candidate to work as part of our UK R&D team and experience the dynamics of a busy technical engineering environment.

As a CAD Design Test Engineer, you will be working as an integral part of the team to help it achieve its objectives of product design and testing and provide manufacturing and customer support.

- You will undertake design activities using our state-of-the-art 3D CAD system and our in-house 3D rapid prototype equipment
- Manage the production of prototypes using in-house manufacturing or external suppliers
- Undertake FEA analysis and prototype testing of new products through the design process
- Build and manage product type tests to British and international standards of new and existing products within the laboratory in Wrexham and external test houses

This position will give you first-hand experience and allow you to have a real impact. There will also be opportunities to gain first-hand experience of project review meetings, some including external customers.

Working at Prysmian has allowed me to learn a lot from those with years of experience. From understanding how to design for manufacture to testing to the required quality and performance standards, the role has been incredibly varied. Civil Engineering Design

Prysmian Group are pleased to offer a 12-month placement within the Utilities Engineering Design Team.

The Utilities Engineering Design Team forms part of our High Voltage Business, which provides customers with a diverse range of services, from the supply of cable to the provision of jointing services to full turn-key installation projects. This role will work closely with internal customers, including the bid team, projects, and Energy Network Solutions (maintenance and repairs) teams. The Design Team are responsible for developing effective, cost-efficient designs for High Voltage Cable systems.

The role will cover civil engineering aspects of designs of high voltage cable installation tenders/projects, including:

- Supporting Project Engineers and Project Managers to develop engineering solutions,
- Developing CAD models/drawings including route plans, excavation works, installation layouts and structural designs,
- Installation design calculations using design templates,
- Producing Bills of Quantities for individual projects,
- Writing up reports for design reviews, tenders and investigations and much more.

You will be involved in real projects in real situations, contributing to the success of the business and by the end of the placement you will have gained a high level of knowledge and experience to help you progress as an engineer (Full training will be provided on industry-specific design methods and terminology etc).

The role will be predominantly office based but there will be opportunities to visit the site to gain hands-on experience on projects.

My time at the High Voltage Installation department in Prysmian Group has been a rewarding journey. Resin

Prysmian Group are pleased to offer a 12-month placement within our Components Business.

The Components business sits in the Energy sector and designs, manufactures, and supplies state-of-the-art low and medium-voltage cable accessories that enable customers' installation requirements. Products we supply hold, join, terminate, and protect our customer's vital cable assets.

This role will give the opportunity to work as part of our UK R&D team and experience the dynamics of a busy technical engineering environment. Working within the Resin R&D team you will design, test, and support a diverse range of resin encapsulation materials used in low and medium-voltage cable accessories. The position will focus on polymer science related to resin-type materials used in cable accessories. However, as part of a multi-disciplinary team, the position will provide you with a broad materials background, together with an appreciation of cable accessory design, materials, and testing.

Typical responsibilities include:

- Undertaking and supporting projects to evaluate new and/or alternative materials to enhance technical performance of existing resin formulations
- Building knowledge of Prysmian's cold pour resin technologies to support the current manufacturing processes
- Work as an integral part of the team to help it achieve its objectives in terms of new product development in the field of cold curing resin systems for cable joint encapsulation and other related products
- Undertake projects for the development of resin formulations for new applications
- Prepare and undertake test programmes associated with existing or new products including bench-marking of Prysmian and competitor products to identify cost

In aid of your personal development, we will assign a PhD qualified engineer as a mentor, who will provide support and advice whilst overseeing your progress.

I'm 2 months into my placement year at Prysmian, and the experience I have gained so far is something staying at university couldn't offer. As a commercial placement, you will:

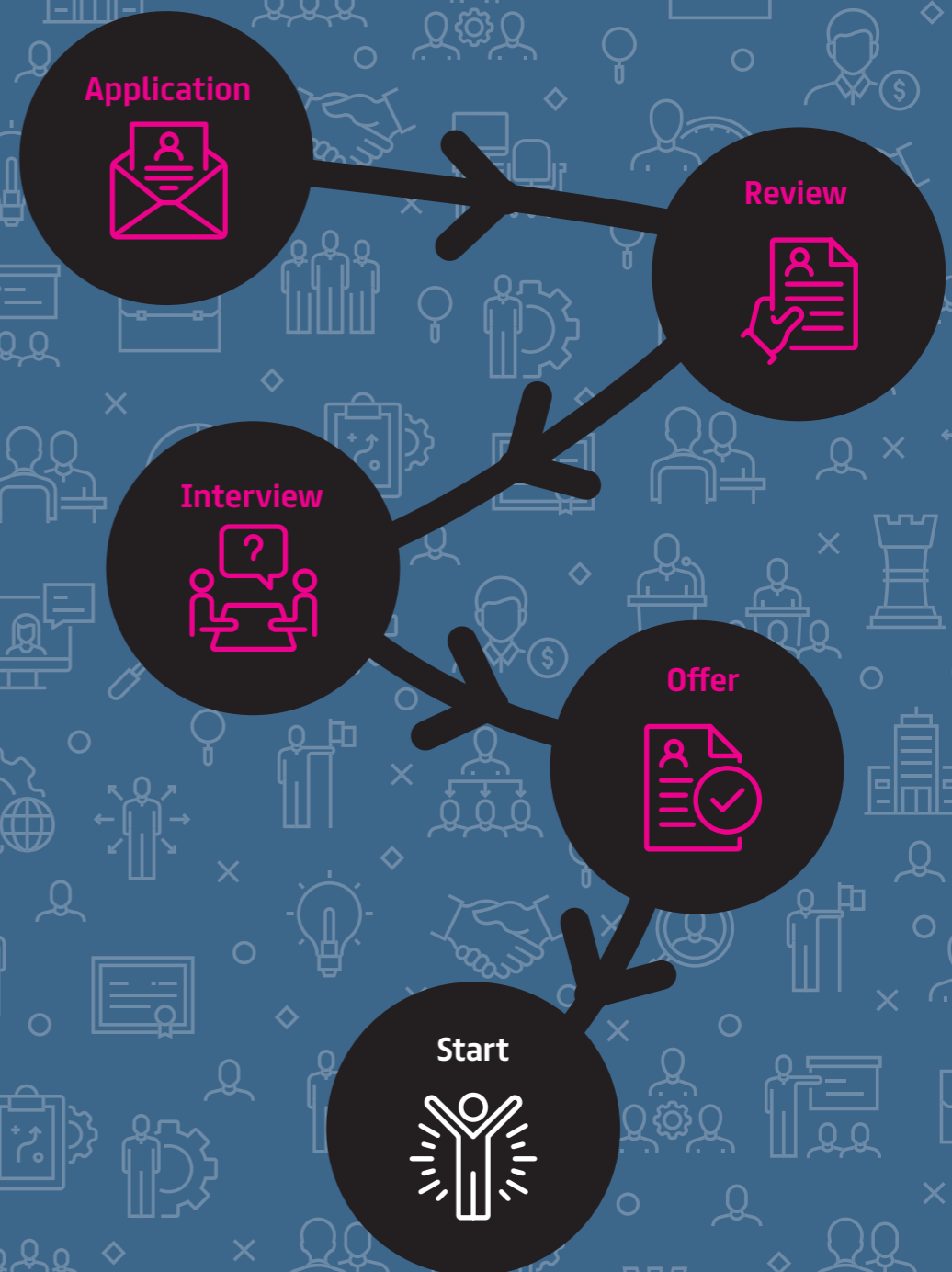
- Maintain regular contact with customers to establish strong relationships

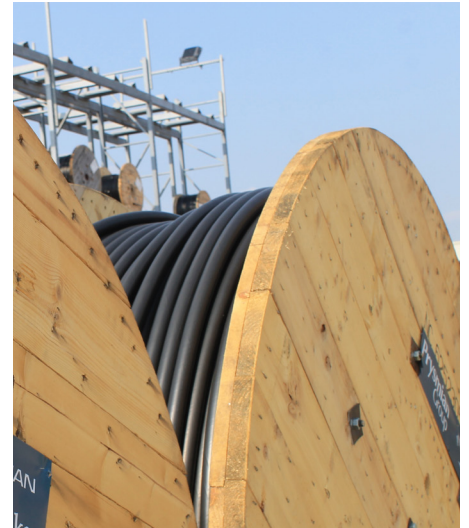

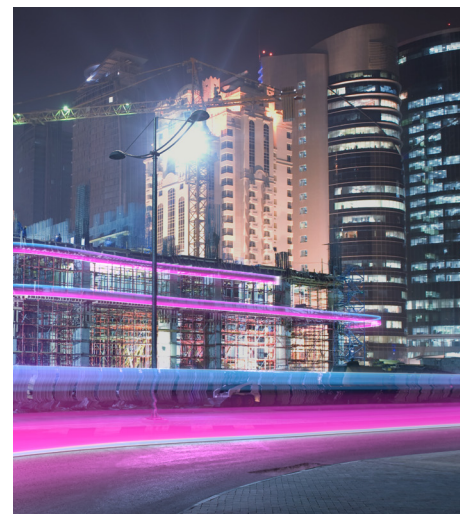
